Tree Sale: The Loveland Tree Corps is offering sizable hardwood trees, in 3 gallon containers, for only \$25 each. All grow well in southwest Ohio and will provide that wonderful, sheltering canopy that feels so good to the human spirit. The available trees are listed on the order form, including some that are appropriate for sites with overhead wires. Mail or deliver completed order forms and checks to Loveland magazine at 514 W. Loveland Ave (next to Union Savings Bank) before September 22. Trees will be available for pick-up on October 6 from 8am to 2pm, at the same location.

Biological Diversity: Biological diversity helps prevent wholesale loss of tree cover when a pest or disease hits your area, such as we are currently experiencing with the Emerald Ash Borer. Pests and diseases often target a single specie, therefore having a greater variety of trees helps protects you against a devastating loss during an epidemic. We are offering some trees that are less frequently planted. They are all beautiful shade trees that do extremely well here. They will help increase the biological diversity within our region.

Beech, American	2-3' (3 gal.)		No	Grand shade tree with beautiful smooth bark.
Catalpa	5-6' (3 gal.)		No	Fast growing tree with abundant white flowers in late spring.
Kentucky Coffeetree	2-3' (3 gal.)		No	Majestic tree, flowers of female trees has rose-like fragrance.
Northern Pecan	3-4' (3 gal.)		No	If you want the trees to produce nuts, you need to plant 2 or more.
Red Oak	4-5' (3 gal.)		No	A fast growing, hardy, majestic oak that commonly reaches 70' in height.
Tulip Poplar	4-5' (3 gal.)		No	Fast growing tree with gold flowers in spring, yellow fall color.
Hornbeam	3-4' (3 gal.)		Yes	Nice rounded shape with yellow/orange/red autumn colors.
Serviceberry	4-6' (3 gal.)		Yes	Fragrant white spring flowers, nice fall color.
