Plant to provide shade for pavement that bakes in the summer sun, to shade your house and reduce your summer AC bill, to improve neighborhood property values, for a friend to make them smile, for environmental reasons, or simply for the sheer beauty that trees provide. Whatever your reason, let's all make our community a little greener.

**Tree Sale:** The Loveland Tree Corps is offering a variety of hardwood trees for \$25 each. They are attractive, hardwood trees that grow well in southwest Ohio. At maturity, each will provide that wonderful, sheltering canopy that encourages outdoor activity. Biological diversity helps prevent wholesale loss of tree cover if a pest or disease hits your area. Therefore, if you are going to plant more than one, a variety of species is recommended. The available trees are listed on the order form below, including some that are appropriate for sites with overhead wires.
