To the Hamilton County Board of Election Commissioners:

My name is Patricia Horton-Sandmayr, a registered voter and resident of Loveland, Ohio.

I hereby protest the part-petitions of Pamela Gross, candidate for Loveland city council. The nominating committee lists 5 residents. The last name, Berney McGee, has an address listed as "274 Shadow Ct., Loveland, OH 45140". The address listed with the Hamilton County Board of Elections is "274 Shadow Wood CT, Loveland, OH 45140". His address is incorrectly listed on all part-petitions. With reasons that follow, I respectfully request that the part-petitions of Pamela Gross, candidate for Loveland city council, be rejected.

Ohio Revised Code Section 3501.38 (C), while defining each signer's residence address, notes "The voting address given on the petition **shall be the address appearing in the registration records at the board of elections.**" (emphasis added).

The language is clear – the addresses listed on the petition SHALL match the registration records. Of all places, the nominating committee's names and addresses should be pristine – they are on every petition.

The Ohio Secretary of State's 2017 Ohio Candidate Requirement Guide handout, page 16, item number 5, uses the word "MUST":

5. Each signer's residence address and the date of signing must be placed on the petition after the elector's signature. The voting address written on the petition **must be the address appearing in the registration records of the board of elections** (emphasis added).

The Charter of the City of Loveland notes in section 10.04, briefly discusses the sponsoring (nominating) committee:

10.04 Each candidate shall have a sponsoring committee of five (5) qualified voters, whose names and addresses shall appear on each copy of the petition....

Commissioners, the words Shall and Must aren't just any words. They order. They mandate. The nominating committee is a required portion of the petition structure. The address of Berney McGee does not match the address on file. It has to be pristine. The part-petitions must be rejected.

Attached to this letter, please find Ohio Revised Code Section 3501.38, the 2017 Ohio Candidate Requirement Guide handout, along with the Nominations section of the Charter of the City of Loveland, OH.

### **3501.38 General rules for petitions and declarations of candidacy.**

All declarations of candidacy, nominating petitions, or other petitions presented to or filed with the secretary of state or a board of elections or with any other public office for the purpose of becoming a candidate for any nomination or office or for the holding of an election on any issue shall, in addition to meeting the other specific requirements prescribed in the sections of the Revised Code relating to them, be governed by the following rules:

(A) Only electors qualified to vote on the candidacy or issue which is the subject of the petition shall sign a petition. Each signer shall be a registered elector pursuant to section 3503.01 of the Revised Code. The facts of qualification shall be determined as of the date when the petition is filed.

(B) Signatures shall be affixed in ink. Each signer may also print the signer's name, so as to clearly identify the signer's signature.

(C) Each signer shall place on the petition after the signer's name the date of signing and the location of the signer's voting residence, including the street and number if in a municipal corporation or the rural route number, post office address, or township if outside a municipal corporation. The voting address given on the petition shall be the address appearing in the registration records at the board of elections.

(D) Except as otherwise provided in section 3501.382 of the Revised Code, no person shall write any name other than the person's own on any petition. Except as otherwise provided in section 3501.382 of the Revised Code, no person may authorize another to sign for the person. If a petition contains the signature of an elector two or more times, only the first signature shall be counted.

(E)

(1) On each petition paper, the circulator shall indicate the number of signatures contained on it, and shall sign a statement made under penalty of election falsification that the circulator witnessed the affixing of every signature, that all signers were to the best of the circulator's knowledge and belief qualified to sign, and that every signature is to the best of the circulator's knowledge and belief the signature of the person whose signature it purports to be or of an attorney in fact acting pursuant to section 3501.382 of the Revised Code. On the circulator's statement for a declaration of candidacy or nominating petition for a person seeking to become a statewide candidate or for a statewide initiative or a statewide referendum petition, the circulator shall identify the circulator's name, the address of the circulator's permanent residence, and the name and address of the person employing the circulator to circulate the petition, if any.

(2) As used in division (E) of this section, "statewide candidate" means the joint candidates for the offices of governor and lieutenant governor or a candidate for the office of secretary of state, auditor of state, treasurer of state, or attorney general.

(F) Except as otherwise provided in section 3501.382 of the Revised Code, if a circulator knowingly permits an unqualified person to sign a petition paper or permits a person to write a name other than the person's own on a petition paper, that petition paper is invalid; otherwise, the signature of a person not qualified to sign shall be rejected but shall not invalidate the other valid signatures on the paper.

(G) The circulator of a petition may, before filing it in a public office, strike from it any signature the circulator does not wish to present as a part of the petition.

(H) Any signer of a petition or an attorney in fact acting pursuant to section 3501.382 of the Revised Code on behalf of a signer may remove the signer's signature from that petition at any time before the petition is filed in a public office by striking the signer's name from the petition; no signature may be removed after the petition is filed in any public office.

(I)

(1) No alterations, corrections, or additions may be made to a petition after it is filed in a public office.

(2)

(a) No declaration of candidacy, nominating petition, or other petition for the purpose of becoming a candidate may be withdrawn after it is filed in a public office. Nothing in this division prohibits a person from withdrawing as a candidate as otherwise provided by law.

(b) No petition presented to or filed with the secretary of state, a board of elections, or any other public office for the purpose of the holding of an election on any question or issue may be resubmitted after it is withdrawn from a public office or rejected as containing insufficient signatures. Nothing in this division prevents a question or issue petition from being withdrawn by the filing of a written notice of the withdrawal by a majority of the members of the petitioning committee with the same public office with which the petition was filed prior to the sixtieth day before the election at which the question or issue is scheduled to appear on the ballot.

(J) All declarations of candidacy, nominating petitions, or other petitions under this section shall be accompanied by the following statement in boldface capital letters: **WHOEVER COMMITS ELECTION FALSIFICATION IS GUILTY OF A FELONY OF THE FIFTH DEGREE.**

(K) All separate petition papers shall be filed at the same time, as one instrument.

(L) If a board of elections distributes for use a petition form for a declaration of candidacy, nominating petition, or any type of question or issue petition that does not satisfy the requirements of law as of the date of that distribution, the board shall not invalidate the petition on the basis that the petition form does not satisfy the requirements of law, if the petition otherwise is valid. Division (L) of this section applies only if the candidate received the petition from the board within ninety days of when the petition is required to be filed.

(M)

(1) Upon receiving an initiative petition, or a petition filed under section 307.94 or 307.95 of the Revised Code, concerning a ballot issue that is to be submitted to the electors of a county or municipal political subdivision, the board of elections shall examine the petition to determine:

(a) Whether the petition falls within the scope of a municipal political subdivision's authority to enact via initiative, including, if applicable, the limitations placed by Sections 3 and 7 of Article XVIII of the Ohio Constitution on the authority of municipal corporations to adopt local police, sanitary, and other similar regulations as are not in conflict with general laws, and whether the petition satisfies the statutory prerequisites to place the issue on the ballot. The petition shall be invalid if any portion of the petition is not within the initiative power; or

(b) Whether the petition falls within the scope of a county's authority to enact via initiative, including whether the petition conforms to the requirements set forth in Section 3 of Article X of the Ohio Constitution, including the exercise of only those powers that have vested in, and the performance of all duties imposed upon counties and county officers by law, and whether the petition satisfies the statutory prerequisites to place the issue on the ballot. The finding of the board shall be subject to challenge by a protest filed pursuant to division (B) of section 307.95 of the Revised Code.

(2) After making a determination under division (M)(1)(a) or (b) of this section, the board of elections shall promptly transmit a copy of the petition and a notice of the board's determination to the office of the secretary of state. Notice of the board's determination shall be given to the petitioners and the political subdivision.

(3) If multiple substantially similar initiative petitions are submitted to multiple boards of elections and the determinations of the boards under division (M)(1)(a) or (b) of this section concerning those petitions differ, the secretary of state shall make a single determination under division (M)(1)(a) or (b) of this section that shall apply to each such initiative petition.

## Petitions

County boards of election will provide at least one copy of a candidate petition form upon request. Candidates are permitted to make copies of the forms in the manner they were provided.

Petitions contain three separate sections:

1. The Statement of Candidacy,
2. The Nominating Petition, and
3. The Circulator's Statement.

## Group Petitions

Ohio law provides for a "group petition" to be used by candidates nominated only by nominating petition for the following offices: member of a board of education, township trustee (in years when two trustees are to be elected), and offices of villages with under 2,000 population. (R.C. 3513.261)

If a group of candidates for one of these offices wants to jointly circulate and file a single petition, they may do so by using the appropriate form:

#3-S township office;

#3-MA offices in villages with under 2,000 population;

#3-U city, local, or exempted village board of education;

#3-X at-large members of education service center; or

#3-YA members of newly formed educational service center.

Each of the candidates named in the group petition must sign the "Statement of Candidacy," and each must pay a separate filing fee. All signatures affixed to the petition are credited to each candidate named on the petition. (R.C. 3513.10, 3513.261)

## Rules Governing Petitions

Below is an overview of the rules governing petitions. For additional information on rules governing petitions, please see Chapter 11 of the Ohio Election Official Manual.

1. The Statement of Candidacy portion of each petition paper must be completely filled out and signed by the candidate(s) before being circulated (R.C. 3513.07, 3513.09, 3513.261).
2. Candidates for county commissioner or judge must designate the term of office on the Declaration of Candidacy or Nominating Petition, if more than one office is to be elected at the election (R.C. 3513.08, 3513.28).
3. Only qualified electors who are eligible to vote on the candidacy may sign a petition. An elector's qualifications are determined as of the date the petition is filed (R.C. 3501.38(A)).

4. Each signature, written in ink, must be an original signature of an elector or the elector's duly appointed attorney-in-fact who is acting pursuant to R.C. 3501.382. Generally, signing or affixing a signature to petition requires a person's written, cursive-style legal mark written in that person's own hand unless the elector does not use a cursive-style mark during the course of his or her regular business or legal affairs. However, a voter with a disability may personally affix his or her signature through the use of a reasonable accommodation, including the use of assistive technology or an augmentative device such as a signature stamp. (R.C. 3501.011, R.C. 3501.382(F) and related OAG 2015-012).
5. Each signer's residence address and the date of signing must be placed on the petition after the elector's signature. The voting address written on the petition must be the address appearing in the registration records of the board of elections (R.C. 3501.38 (C)).
6. Petitions for a candidate for party nomination must be signed and circulated by persons who are members of the same political party as the candidate (R.C. 3513.07). An elector is considered to be a member of a political party if he or she voted in the primary election of that party within the preceding two calendar years, or if he or she did not vote in any other party's primary election within the preceding two calendar years (R.C. 3513.05, 7th paragraph).
7. A candidate may circulate his or her own petition, although he or she may not sign his or her own petition as an elector. For purposes of circulating his or her own petition, a candidate is exempted from the party affiliation requirements described in number 6 of this section (R.C. 3513.191(C)(4)). A circulator may not sign the same petition paper that he or she is circulating. A circulator may, however, sign a petition paper being circulated for the same candidacy by a different circulator.
8. A circulator must be at least 18 years of age (R.C. 3503.06(C)). (The Ohio residency requirement is not currently in place based on the preliminary injunction in *Citizens in Charge v. Husted*, Case: 2:13-cv-00935 (S.D. Ohio 11/13/13)).
9. After circulating the petition, the circulator must sign a statement, under penalty of election falsification indicating the following:
  - a. The number of signatures contained on the petition;
  - b. That the circulator witnessed the affixing of each signature on the petition;
  - c. That all signers, to the best of the circulator's knowledge and belief, were qualified to sign; and

10. That each signature is, to the best of the circulator's knowledge and belief, the signature of the person whose signature it purports to be.
11. If a circulator knowingly permits an unqualified person to sign a petition paper or permits a person to write a name other than the person's own on the petition paper, that petition paper is invalid; otherwise, the signature of a person not qualified to sign shall be rejected but shall not invalidate the other valid signatures on the petition paper (R.C. 3501.38(F)).
12. Once a candidate's petition has been filed with the appropriate election official, it cannot be changed, supplemented, or returned to the candidate.
13. The original petition with the candidate's original signature must be filed at the same time as all part petitions are filed (R.C. 3501.38(K), 3513.09).
14. Each petition paper shall be circulated by one person only, and shall contain signatures of qualified electors of one county only. When petitions are circulated in a district that contains more than one county, separate petition papers must be circulated in each county (R.C. 3501.38, 3513.05, 3513.07, 3513.261).
15. No petition shall be accepted if it contains more than three times the minimum number of required signatures (R.C. 3513.05, 3513.257, 3513.259).
16. All petitions must contain the following statement in boldface capital letters: "WHOEVER COMMITS ELECTION FALSIFICATION IS GUILTY OF A FELONY OF THE FIFTH DEGREE." (R.C. 3501.38(J), 3599.36).

**Note:** The penalties for a fifth degree felony conviction are six to 12 months in prison and/or a fine of \$2,500.

17. All petitions remain open for public inspection, under reasonable regulations, at the board of elections at which they were filed (R.C. 3513.05, 3513.262).

**SECTION 10.01 MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS.**

The regular election for the choice of members of the Council shall be held at the general election in the odd-numbered years. This shall be known as the Municipal Election. The Council may, by resolution, order a Special Election at any time, the purpose of which shall be set forth in the resolution.

**SECTION 10.02 CONDUCT OF ELECTIONS.**

All elections shall be conducted under the provisions of this Charter by the Board of Elections of the respective counties in which the City lies. Where the Charter is silent, the provisions of the laws of Ohio shall be followed.

**SECTION 10.03 NOMINATIONS.**

No primary election shall be held for the nomination of candidates for Council. Nominations for the office of Council member shall be made by petition signed by not less than twenty-five (25) nor more than fifty (50) electors of the City. Petitions shall be the standard forms for the nomination of individual nonpartisan candidates for such office. Group petitions shall not be used. Petitions shall be filed with the Board of Elections within the time period specified by the Ohio Revised Code. An elector may sign only as many petitions as there are Council members to be elected at the Municipal election for which the nominations are made.

**SECTION 10.04 SPONSORS, ACCEPTANCE, VERIFICATION.**

Each candidate shall have a sponsoring committee of five (5) qualified voters, whose names and addresses shall appear on each copy of the petition. The signature of the candidate indicating acceptance of the nomination and willingness to serve if elected shall appear on each copy of the petition. The petition may be in a number of parts, but each part shall be verified under oath by the circulator, as required by law.
