LES - Preschool Classroom

Hazards, Practices, Procedures, Protective Equipment (PPE) & Controls

Space Description: A classroom (typically 40' by 28') with one entrance/exit door. Teachers use this room for small group instruction. Chairs and activity centers must be placed to ensure a minimum of 6 ft. between students.

Uses:

Preschool – small group instruction

Special Needs students - individualized instruction and support

CONTROL REQUIREMENTS

- Teacher will sit in center chair for circle time
 Each seated position is marked with tape on floor or mat
- Mask may be temporarily removed (pulled away from face)
 when activities require student or teacher to observe and model techniques for forming sounds with their mouths
- Teacher will need a face covering with a clear cutout OR a face shield and mask

 Establish seating charts for each group of students

ENTRY PROCEDURES EXIT PROCEDURES

Students will be masked and enter the room. If needed, teacher will direct students where to sit.
 Teacher will escort children from the room ensuring 6-foot distance is maintained

ACTIVITIES/TASKS PROCEDURES

- Maximum occupancy 8 students

 No additional students should be brought into the room than the number of seats available
- Chair disinfection

 Each chair will be wiped down with disinfectant after each use
- Loitering

 Students remain seated. Once students get up, they should leave the area to their next designated place
- Mask may be temporarily removed (pulled away from face) of teacher or student but not both at the same time.
 Sanitize hands with alcohol after instruction period if mask surfaces were touched.

PITFALLS / VIGILANCE / MONITORING

- Bringing in additional chairs or desks
- Moving chairs to < 6 feet apart
- Masks worn but not covering mouth and nose
- Students not sitting in marked location
- Students touching face covering surface
- Not sanitizing hands after instruction if masks were touched
- Not cleaning/sanitizing after use
