Space Description: There are two stalls and two sinks in the girl's restroom (located adjacent to Classroom 8). Uses: Toilet facilities Handwashing **CONTROL REQUIREMENTS** • Reduce Crowding - Classes designated a use period Students wash or disinfect hands before leaving room • Face coverings required AT ALL TIMES • Paper towels used for turning off tap once hands are clean • Paper towels used for opening door to exit (if present) once • Maximum Occupancy - 2 persons (number of stalls) • hands are clean Spacing while waiting in line at 6 feet along wall Trash can is placed at exit to encourage towel use to exit • • ENTRY PROCEDURES EXIT PROCEDURES Classes will be designated at specific times. Students Once finished using the stall each student will wash hands • will be masked and enter the restroom keeping 6 ft and exit the restroom and get in line at the end or proceed from each other and go directly to a stall. back to classroom as directed by teacher **ACTIVITIES/TASKS** PROCEDURES Greater than 2 persons in room Loading limits should be firmly adhered to • • Students shall not remain in the restroom if not actively . Loitering prohibited • using it Hands should be disinfected before leaving the restroom. • Soap and water should be used. 20 seconds of vigorous Hand disinfection • scrubbing on the front, back, between fingers and up to wrists for 20 seconds (sing "Old McDonald" verse). Once hands are clean leave water running, use a paper • Exit procedure towel to dry hands then shut off water, the hand should • touch nothing, but the drying towel once rinsed.
