

# LHS – Art Classroom

## Hazards, Practices, Procedures, Protective Equipment (PPE) & Controls

**Space Description:** An art classroom (approximately 34' by 44') with one entrance/exit door. Tables and equipment must be placed to ensure a minimum of 6 ft. between students. Tables must be placed where the distance from the edge of one table to the similar edge of the next table is  $\geq 6$  ft.

**Uses:** Art instruction

### CONTROL REQUIREMENTS

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| <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Student capacity <b>Rooms 277 &amp; 278 – one student per table</b></li> <li>• Student capacity <b>Room 281 – two students per table</b></li> </ul> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Students must sit in assigned seats</li> </ul>  |
| <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Tables spaced at 6 feet; seating positions marked with tape</li> </ul>  | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Face coverings required AT ALL TIMES</li> </ul> |

### ENTRY PROCEDURES

- Students will be masked and enter the room.
- Students will be assigned seats

### EXIT PROCEDURES

- Teacher will dismiss children from the room ensuring 6-foot distance is maintained (no bottlenecking at door)

### ACTIVITIES/TASKS

- Maximum occupancy – **Rooms 277 and 278 – one student per table, Room 281 – two students per table (on a diagonal)**
- Cleaning
- Shared/Community item cleaning
- Shared/Community item reuse

### PROCEDURES

- Occupancy limits should be firmly adhered to
- Nightly cleaning with standard disinfectants is sufficient
- Clean after each use
- Assure contact time from cleaner's directions is met

### PITFALLS / VIGILANCE / MONITORING

- No moving or bringing in additional chairs or desks
- No moving chairs to < 6 feet apart
- Masks worn not covering mouth and nose
