LMS Music Classroom

Hazards, Practices, Procedures, Protective Equipment (PPE) & Controls

Space Description: A music classroom with one main entrance/exit door and built-in risers.

Uses:

Music instruction – Vocalized without amplification; instruments

CONTROL REQUIREMENTS

- Student capacity: varies with 6 or 13-foot spacing
- Student and instructors will wear face coverings
- Use of wind instruments prohibited (recorders, etc.)

ENTRY PROCEDURES

- Students will have face coverings in place and enter the room.
- Students will be assigned seats

ACTIVITIES/TASKS

- Maximum occupancy varies
- Cleaning room
- Cleaning shared items
- Demonstrating vocal technique

PITFALLS / VIGILANCE / MONITORING

- Proper mask wear fully covering nose and mouth, if masks come off or down during singing a new mask style may be required.
- Contact time of disinfectant not sufficient between student uses

• Occupants will keep 6 feet apart

- Shared instruments disinfected after each use with spray disinfectant
 - Instructor will use a face shield if needing to observe student with mask down temporarily for instruction

EXIT PROCEDURES

 Teacher will dismiss children from the room ensuring 6-foot distance is maintained (no bottlenecking at door)

PROCEDURES

- Occupancy limits should be firmly adhered to
- Nightly cleaning with standard disinfectants is sufficient
- Clean after each use with spray disinfectant
